

Points of Interest

Kremlin [B4] 1



The Kremlin is an ancient fortress situated in the center of Moscow. Seize the occasion to see the Kremlin walls and towers. Once inside you can enjoy the views of the famous cathedrals in Cathedral Square, visit the museums, including the Armory and the Patriarch's Chamber, and stroll through Red Square, getting an eyeful of the impressive St. Basil's Cathedral.

Zaryadye Park [B5] 2



Zaryadye Park is an innovative cultural and educational center near the Red Square. In the park you'll find a unique botanical collection from some of the various different natural zones of Russia and visit the Polet flying cinema, the Time Machine 360 panorama, the exhibition hall, the Ice Cave, the Florarium scientific and educational center and greenhouse complex, the underground interactive museum, the Large Amphitheatre and the Concert Hall and the best observation deck in the city — the floating bridge — which offers scenic views of the historical center of Moscow.


Gorky Park [C3] 3



Gorky Park is one of the most fashionable open spaces in the city. Here you can not only walk and relax, but also do sports and activities. The park has special tracks for cycling and rollerskating as well as badminton and beach volleyball courts. In summer you can go out on the water in boats, and on paddle boats, and in winter you can go ice skating. The park has a huge playground for children with unusual and original games and attractions.

MAMM [C3] 5



MAMM specialises in photography. Here you can find a permanent exhibition on display but in addition to this there are regular temporary exhibitions. Every year the museum organises large-scale biennales. On odd years there is a photobiennale and on even years there is the "Fashion and style in photography" biennale. The Museum houses and supports The Alexander Rodchenko School of Photography and Multimedia.

VDNH & The Space Pavilion [C3] 6



At VDNH you can learn about the USSR and some of its most interesting aspects. VDNH (Exhibition of Achievements of National Economy) is a giant exhibition complex which was built in 1939. Here you can explore Soviet architecture and sculptures, visit one of the many museums, go rollerblading or cycling, or just walk around. Be sure to visit the Space pavilion. This is one of the most remarkable pavilions of the VDNH complex. There is now a Cosmonautics and Aviation center situated inside it.

Moscow City [B1] 8



Moscow City (Moscow International Business Center) is a business development situated in the west of the capital. The quarter naturally fits into the architectural image of the city, and today Moscow can no longer be imagined without it. PANORAMA360, Europe's highest observation deck, is situated on the 89th floor of the Federation Tower. The area offers an impressive view over the metropolis.

Moscow Zoo [B2] 9



The Moscow Zoo, founded in 1864, is one of the oldest zoos in Europe. It is located on a 21 hectare area in the center of the capital. The animals in the zoo are provided with comfortable conditions, as close as possible to their natural habitats. Here you can see capybaras, meerkats, Pallas's cats and other animals, as well as learn more about them and their habitat.


Tsaritsyno Park and Royal Estate [C3] 11



Catherine II, who bought Tsaritsyno and ordered a palace complex to be built there, did not actually settle in her new estate. Some of the buildings have been preserved to this day and have been reconstructed. Now Tsaritsyno is one of the most beautiful parks in Moscow. Both residents and guests of the capital love to go and relax there.

Jewish Museum and Tolerance Center [C3] 13



This is the most technologically advanced museum in Moscow. It allows visitors to get acquainted with the history of the Jewish people in an interactive way. The activity of the museum is aimed at studying Jewish culture and their religious traditions. The museum has an educational and research center, as well as the Avant-Garde Center, which conducts educational lectures and seminars on art and culture from 1910–1930s.

Stalin's seven skyscrapers, known as the Seven Sisters, were intended as a symbol of the restoration of the capital of the USSR after the Second World War. These monumental buildings are still significant for the country.

The Flacon Design Quarter [C3] 15



Flacon Design Factory is the first creative cluster of the capital organized on the premises of a former crystal glass factory. This place very quickly became the center of the city's cultural life and the venue for self-expression of creative individuals. Two-minutes away from Flacon there is a pedestrian space called Heblozovod, which means bakery. On the reconstructed territory of the former bakery machine of Soviet times, built in the style of constructivism, offices, cafes and shops are now open. Recently, both of these spaces have united, becoming the largest creative platform in the country — the Flacon design quarter.

Four Museums Route

- 16 Garage Museum of Contemporary Art
- 17 State Tretyakov Gallery and the New Tretyakov Gallery
- 18 The Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts
- 19 GES-2 is the Moscow building of the V-A-C Foundation, situated on the territory of a former power plant of the same name. It will open in 2020.

The cultural space in the city center, the equivalent of the New York Museum Mile, Berlin's Museum Island or the Vienna MuseumsQuartier, offers many options for leisure, from the rich heritage of world art to modern artistic practices. Walking or cycling along the embankments of the Moskva river can now become almost like an excursion, with many different opportunities available to the public.



Garage Museum of Contemporary Art [C3] 16

The main museum of modern art in Moscow is located in Gorky Park. The museum building, reconstructed by the world-famous architect Rem Koolhaas, hosts exhibitions of world-famous Russian and foreign artists, as well as free lectures, master classes for visitors of all ages and events for visitors with disabilities.

In Arts Square in summer you can watch films in the Garage Screen Pavilion and attend Mosaic Music concerts.

Tretyakov Gallery & New Tretyakov Gallery [C4] 17

The museum was founded by philanthropist Pavel Tretyakov in the 19th century. Having collected a vast collection of paintings by Russian artists in his estate, he opened it to the public. Later the gallery became owned by the state and now there is a huge collection of Russian fine art on display, from ancient Russian icons to the works of modernists.

A branch of the Tretyakov Gallery situated on Krymskiy Val. In the New Tretyakov Gallery, paintings from the 20th and 21st centuries, created by Soviet and Russian artists, are on display. From Kandinsky and Chagall to the works of modern Russian artists, all of Russia's major art has been collected here in one place.

Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts [B4] 18

The Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts is a museum complex which has one of the largest collections of foreign art in Russia. Today the collection contains about 700 thousand works from different eras: from ancient Egypt and ancient Greece to the beginning of the 21st century. The Gallery of European and American Art of the 19th and 20th centuries has one of the most famous collections of European modernism in the world from the collections of Sergey Shchukin and Ivan Morozov.

The most convenient way to get to Moscow from the Sheremetyevo, Domodedovo and Vnukovo airports is by the aerexpress high-speed-rail. Website: aerexpress.ru

Taxis in Moscow

The easiest way to book a taxi in Moscow is by using the various applications from the largest companies: **Yandex.Taxi**, **Citymobil**, **Gett** and **Uber Russia**.

Upon booking, the applications immediately show what car will arrive, the name of the driver and how much the trip will cost.

Bikesharing

You don't have to walk or use public transport to get around Moscow — you can rent a bike.

You can register yourself in the bike rental system either using the **Velobike** application, at a station terminal or at velobike.ru website.

You pay for your rental with a card and off you go! Trips for up to 30 minutes are free and bikes can be taken from one station and returned to any other.

Carsharing

Moscow carsharing is convenient and inexpensive. Download the operator's application on your smartphone, register, upload photos of documents (passport, driving license) and wait for confirmation of registration.

The largest car sharing companies are **Yandex.Drive**, **YouDrive**, **BelkaCar**, **MatreshCar** and **Delimobil**.

If you find yourself at Vorobyovy Gory, be sure to take a ride in the cable car which connects the viewing platform with the Luzhniki Stadium.

You can enjoy beautiful views over Moscow from the comfortable closed cabins.

Sightseeing bus

In Moscow, just like in many other cities, CitySightseeing buses run. You can explore the city sights by buying a ticket for the famous red double-decker buses.

Sitting by the window or on the upper deck, you will be able to see all the most important and interesting things in the city and of course, hear about Moscow's sights in 10 languages through a multilingual audio guide. Thanks to the Hop-On Hop-Off system, you can buy one ticket and during its validity period, hop off the bus and then hop back on as many times as you like, when and where it is convenient.

River cruises

You can sail along the river through the center of Moscow at any time of the year, even in winter. Navigation along the Moskva river is possible 365 days a year.

Guided cruises on the Radisson Royal Flotilla ice-class yachts, which have on-board restaurants, allow you to see the capital from a different angle. Cruises depart every 30 minutes from 8 wharfs. There are theatrical and gastronomic cruises and entertainment for children at weekends.

Bolshoi Theater [B4] 20

The main national theater of Russia, which preserves the best traditions of the Russian and the world music culture. The repertoire mainly includes masterpieces of the 19th — 20th centuries, as well as the world classics, including recognized masterpieces of the 20th century, and specially ordered compositions.

After a grand restoration and reconstruction, the auditorium of the Bolshoi Theater attained its original beauty. The magnificent decor of the theater has been restored, giving it the appearance of a palace from fairy tales: bright crimson drapes of the lodges interior strewn with gold, unique plastering arabesques and a beautiful "Apollo and the Muses" ceiling piece.

Metro Tours

The Moscow Metro is a unique underground museum, in which various tours take place. On the tours you will pass through the most beautiful metro stations (44 of them are recognised as cultural heritage sites) and learn interesting and little-known facts about the metro. It's easy to go on a tour: go to the website and choose your tour, date and time.

On the photo you can see Prospekt Mira station of the Ring Line. The theme of the decoration of this station, which was opened in 1952, is the agriculture of the USSR. The facade of the lobby is decorated with sculptures and original clock. Inside you can see the "Mothers of the World" small panel. For many years this station remains one of the most popular among tourists.
